- D. What was special about wine mixed with gall/myrrh and Jesus' refusal of it?
- E. What was controversial about the inscription over Jesus' head?
- F. Research the typical crucifixion process and what happened to the victim physically and mentally as a result.
- G. What Old Testament prophecies were fulfilled during the crucifixion process?
- H. What do we learn from Jesus' interaction with the two thieves?
- I. Explain the "Seven Sayings" of Jesus on the cross?
- J. What miraculous signs happened when Jesus finally died? What was the Roman centurion's conclusion?
- K. What is medically significant about blood & water coming out of Jesus' pierced side?
- L. Some people say Jesus became a sinner on the cross (guilty of our sins), died in our place (so we would not have to), or paid the debt for all of our sins (past, present, and future). Are these scriptural concepts?
