Lesson 22 – Review of Major & Minor Prophets (part 1)

Part 1 covers the prophetic books describing events between the division of the United Kingdom and the fall of the Northern Kingdom.

A. For the book of Obadiah, answer the following questions.

- a) When did the events in the book occur (approximate B.C. dates)?
- b) Who was the most likely audience?
- c) What are the overall theme(s) of the book?
- d) What are one or two notable lessons we can learn from the book for use today?

B. Answer the same a) thru d) questions for the book of Joel. In addition:

- e) What can you find out about locusts in the Bible?

C. Answer the same a) thru d) questions for the book of Jonah. In addition:

- e) Can you find any parallels between what happened to Jonah and Jesus Christ? (Hint: use your OT-NT cross-reference.)

D. Answer the same a) thru d) questions for the book of Amos. In addition:

- e) What can you find out about different kinds of idolatry and false gods in the Bible? In what ways is idolatry a problem in America today?

E. Answer the same a) thru d) questions for the book of Hosea. In addition:

- e) The names of Bible characters generally have an underlying meaning (unlike many modern names). What is significant about the names of Hosea's children?

F. Answer the same a) thru d) questions for the book of Isaiah. In addition:

- e) List the parallels between the "Suffering Servant" of Isaiah 53 and Jesus Christ.

G. Answer the same a) thru d) questions for the book of Micah. In addition:

- e) Can you find a Messianic prophecy in Micah? (Hint: use your OT-NT cross-reference.)
