The Word of Men or of God

For this reason we also thank God without ceasing, because when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you welcomed it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you who believe 1Th. 2:13

Could Paul also thank God for us here today? How deep are our convictions?

Can we say with no hesitancy: we have no doubt Every word in Scripture is absolute truth!

Are we Confidant about:

Adam & Eve in the beginning Mt. 19:4-6 Lk. 17:26-27 Noah & the Ark Lk. 17:28-29 Lot & destruction of Sodom Lot's wife a pillar of salt Lk. 17:32 2Pet. 2:15-16 Balaam's talking donkey Mt. 12:38-39 Jonah in fish 3 days & nights 2Cor. 11:3 Eve and the Serpent

If we reject them in the OT, we run aground in the New. If Moses and OT writers were wrong so was Jesus! Paul! Peter!

All or Nothing

Our God will not allow us to parcel up Scripture.

All Scripture given by inspiration 2Tim 3:16-17

Either Genesis to Revelation is all inspired of God or none of it is.

If Moses was wrong in any part of Genesis or the Law, then ALL his writings must be rejected: when a prophet speaks in the name of the Lord, if the thing does not happen or come to pass, that is the thing which the Lord has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously; you shall not be afraid of him. Deut 18:22

God wants us to fully understand the nature of inspiration.

He explained it carefully and precisely.

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work. 2 Tim 3:16-17

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God explained the exact details and process by which His thoughts were God breathed into Scripture in 1Cor 2:9-14

9 ... The THINGS which God has prepared for those who love Him." 10 But God has revealed THEM to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all THINGS, yes, the deep **THINGS** of God. 11 For what man knows the **THINGS** of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? The Things of a Man (How We Think)

No one knows our things/thoughts except our own spirit which is within us.

- 1. We think out an idea (concept)
- 2. We put that idea into words
- 3. We convey that idea to others
- 4. We expect that idea to be done exactly as we planned so we make it clear to:
- 5. Architect; Creator; Manufacturer; etc.

The Things of God (How God Thinks)

No one knows God's things/thoughts except the Holy Spirit so:

- 1. God planned out ideas (concepts)
- 2. The Spirit put those ideas into words
- 3. Spirit conveyed it directly into their mind
- 4. God expected it to be done exactly as He planned.


