- Grass, Herbs, Trees a brief summation of the entire world of vegetation!
























The Application: 1Cor 15:36-38

• That which you sow does not come to life unless it dies;

that which you sow, you do not sow the body which is to be, but a bare grain, perhaps of wheat or of something else. But God gives it a body just as He wished to each of the seeds a body of its own The Word conformed this with His Power!

Each Seed Dies when Sown

- When sown, time as a seed is finished.
- Just as the seed rots away (dies)
- new life begins moving toward surface.
- If we had not seen we could not believe!
- Each seed dies producing an entirely different body than itself.
- Each seed sends a new body and a new life into the world.

- So also is the resurrection of the dead.
- The body is sown in corruption, it is raised in incorruption.
- It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory.
- It is sown in weakness, it is raised in power.
- It is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. 1 Cor. 15:42-44

7 But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ. 8 Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ ... 11 if, by any means, I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.
