


Only See Thru things Made

- For the invisible things of him since the creation of the world are clearly seen, being perceived through the things that are made, (even) his everlasting power and divinity; Rom 1:20
- It has been this way since the Creation!
- God's Invisible attributes can't be seen
- His Eternal Power and His divinity...
- Only perceived through things that are made

So also Resurrection of the Dead

- Can only be perceived through things made
- But someone will say, "How are the dead raised up? And with what body do they come?" 36 Foolish one, what you sow is not made alive unless it dies. 37 And what you sow, you do not sow that body that shall be, but mere grain perhaps wheat or some other grain. 38 But God gives it a body as He pleases, and to each seed its own body.
