- What is <u>the gospel</u>
- Jesus dealt with the results of the preaching of the gospel. Not the content.

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all things that I have <u>commanded you</u>; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen. <u>Mt. 28:18-20</u> Make Disciples of all nations baptizing them.

Teach them to observe all I have commanded you.

Gospel

Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, 47 and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. <u>Lk</u> <u>24:46-47</u>
