God Affirmed

God Affirmed

Full public commitment to Jesus as: –King. Jn 18:36; I Tim 6:12-13.

• Jesus answered, My kingdom is not of this world: if My kingdom were of this world, then would My servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is My kingdom not from hence. 37 Pilate therefore said unto him, Are you a king then? Jesus answered, you say that I am a king. To this end have I been born, and to this end am I come into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. John 18:36-37

Confession

Why Some Waver and Let Go

- These things said his parents, because they feared the Jews: for the Jews had agreed already, that if any man should confess him (to be) Christ, he should be put out of the synagogue. John 9:22
- Nevertheless even of the rulers many believed on him; but because of the Pharisees they did not confess (it), lest they should be put out of the synagogue: 43 for they loved the glory (that is) of men more than the glory (that is) of God. <u>Jn</u> <u>12:42-43</u>
