 - God's Will must be done!

Our Work at Holly Street

- Downstairs in the office are two binders.
- One contains the business meeting notes that summarizes the decisions made on the work being done.
- The other contains the financial reports.
 - Money contributed each week listed on a monthly basis.
 - The work this church is doing with its money is listed.

Our Work at Holly Street

- Evangelism (88%):
 - Full time evangelist
 - Evangelist in Louisville KY
 - Evangelist in Sunnyside WA
 - Evangelist in Hermiston OR
 - 21 Evangelists in the Central Region of Malawi
- Edification (11%):
 - Money spent on building we use to preach and teach the gospel and edify the saints.
- Benevolence (As Needed)
 - We set aside a certain amount of money each year to take care of the benevolent needs of the saints.

When the Need Arises

- Sometimes a church is faced with a need that exceeds its ability to meet.
- When this happens, an appeal is made to the brethren to make greater sacrifices.
- Then one of them, named Agabus, stood up and showed by the Spirit that there was going to be a great famine throughout all the world, which also happened in the days of Claudius Caesar. 29 Then the disciples, each according to his ability, determined to send relief to the brethren dwelling in Judea. 30 This they also did, and sent it to the elders by the hands of Barnabas and Saul. Acts 11:28-30


A request from the Elders at Mponela
