
#### Serving One Another

- You sing to me and I sing to you. We are both singing and we are both singing one to another.




### Reciprocity is Universal

- Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another; Rom 12:10
- Owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law. Rom 13:8
- And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you. Eph 4:32
- bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. Col 3:13

# Universal Reciprocity = Same Care Suffer with –Rejoice with One Another

But God composed the body, having given greater honor to that part which lacks it, 25 that there should be no schism in the body, but that the members should have the same care for one another. 26 And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; or if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it. 27 Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually. 1 Cor 12:24-27


#### Which Relationships? - All!

#### Submitting One Another

- 21 submitting to one another in the fear of God.22 Wives, to your own husbands, as to the Lord.
- 25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, 28 So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself. 29 For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord does the church.
