How do We Get In Christ

- Close spiritual relationship. fellowship & brotherhood shared with Jesus as Savior, Lord, and King.
- Can't be a new creation until in Christ, because that's where power of the blood places us after forgiveness
- Faith, (Mk. 16:16)
- Repentance, (Acts 2:38)
- Confession, (Rom. 10:9-10)
- These are steps that must be taken in obedience to the gospel plan of salvation.
- But even after all these things are done, we are still dead in our trespasses and sins until we are buried with him in baptism.

Rom 6:3-8; Gal 3:27; Col 2:11-13;

- For as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death. Rom 6:3
- Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism. <u>Rom. 6:4</u>
- "For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. Gal. 3:27
- These are not my words.
- They are not "church of Christ" doctrine.
- They are the words of the New Testament!
- How else could we possibly interpret them?

Baptism

Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? 4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. 5 For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, 6 knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. <u>Rom</u> 6.3-7

buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. 13 And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, <u>Col 2:12-14</u>

Putting these truths in Order

- Even after believing, repenting and confessing, still "*dead in your trespasses,*"
- When we were "buried with Him in baptism," "through faith in the working of God," "our old man was crucified with Him."
- After we "died with Him," we were "made alive together with Him."
- As we are raised up out of that water, we are "raised with Him to walk in newness of life." Col. 2:11-13; Rom. 6:3-7
