## We Will or Have all Faced This

- For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; 4 and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables. 2 Tim 4:3-4
- Has that time ever come for you?
- Sometimes it lasts a few moments...
- .... A few days .... A few years ... A lifetime...

### Love Truth Until It Costs Too Much

- Now a certain ruler asked Him, saying, "Good Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?"
- 20 You know the commandments: 'Do not commit adultery,' 'Do not murder,' 'Do not steal,' 'Do not bear false witness,' 'Honor your father and your mother.'" 21 And he said, "All these things I have kept from my youth."
- These made sense ... Did not cost him anything...
- ... You still lack one thing. Sell all that you have and distribute to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me." 23 But when he heard this, he became very sorrowful, for he was very rich. Lk 18:18-23

#### We Have All Felt That Sorrow

- That initial sinking feeling when the truth crashes into something near and dear to our heart:
- Entertainment: Drinking, Gambling, Violent TV programs; immodest, jealousy and envy soaps.
- Job: violates Scripture; Finances: give more than 10%
- Leisure Time: Every Service... Read Bible, Pray
- Hobbies: Too much time, money, immoral...
- Marriage and Family ... Love Father or Mother, etc.
- Social standing ... put you out of the synagogue.
- What do we / have we done?
- It affects conscience, zeal and integrity.
- But a fable is a fable ... no matter how small.

## We Become Ripe for the Harvest

- with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 11 And for this reason God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the lie, 12 that they all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness. 2Th. 2:9-12
- We have all seen it ... maybe didn't recognize it.
- When people leave truth there is always a reason
- Something cost more than they wanted to pay.
- The sold the truth
- Buy the truth, and do not sell it, Also wisdom and instruction and understanding. <u>Prov 23:23</u>

## The Driving Force and Motivation

- Behind idolatry... people worship another God so they can reject God's commands
- Denominations; people leave the Lord's church so they can reject Jesus' commands.
- Reject inspiration: so they can do what the Holy Spirit through the apostles forbids.

- For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, 19 because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it to them. Rom 1:18-20
- who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen. Rom 1:25

## Our Greatest Challenge

- Must abide in Jesus word in order to know the truth and for the truth to make us free.
- Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. 32 And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." John 8:31-32
- Whatever the sacrifice it must be paid in order to abide in His word. The truth cannot make us free if we do not abide in it. The greater the sacrifice the more love for truth.
