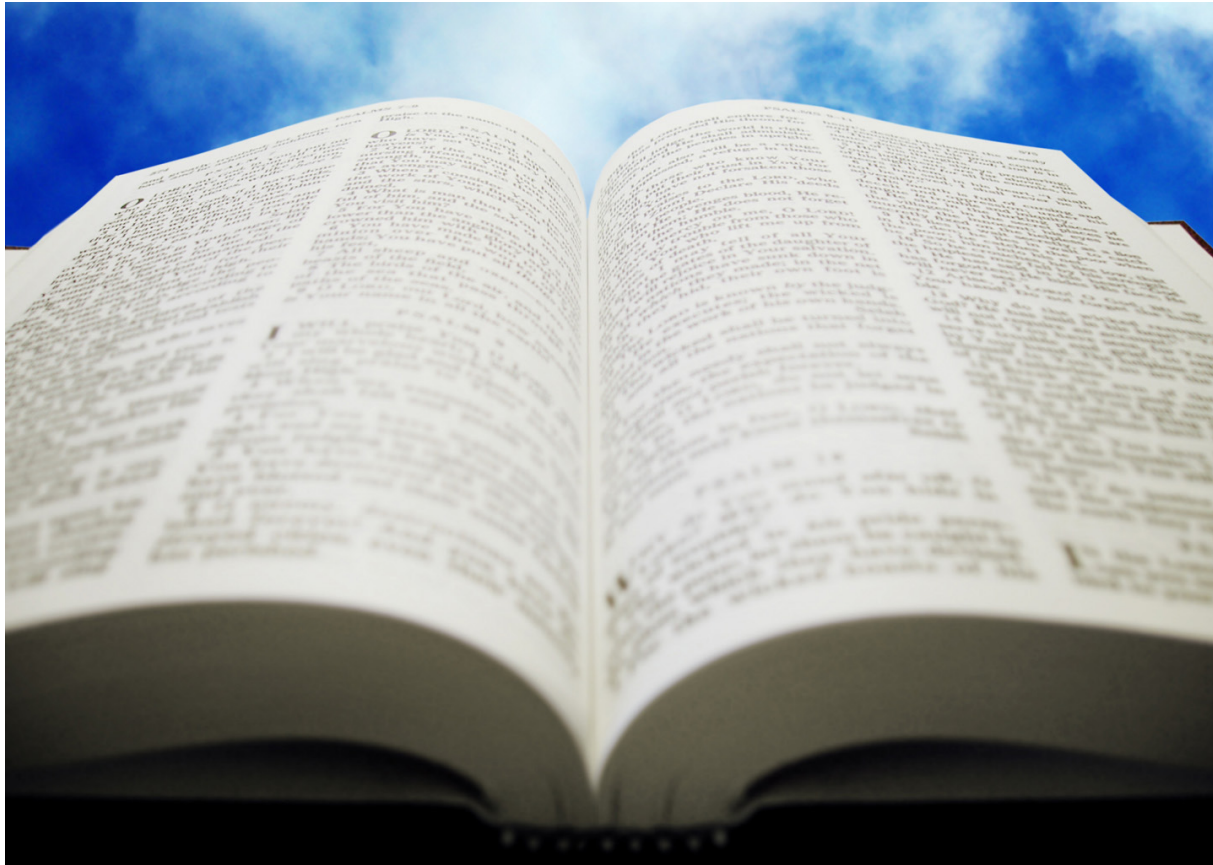

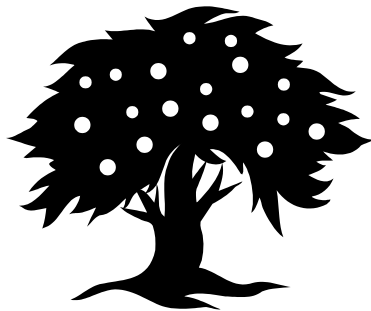


Just One....

“But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?”



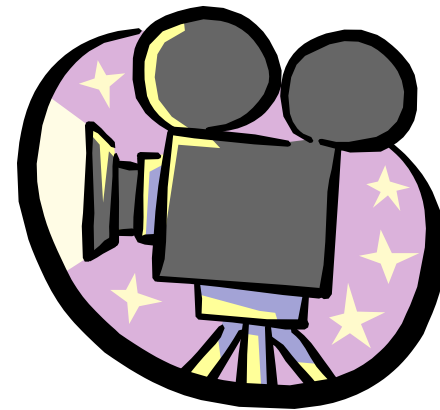

James 2:10

God does not allow selective obedience. We cannot choose to obey the parts of the law that are to our own liking and disregard the rest. Some of the Pharisees were guilty of this. They carefully observed some of the requirements of the Law, such as keeping the Sabbath, and ignored others, such as honoring their parents (Matt.15:1-7). Sin is violation of the perfect righteousness of God, who is the Lawgiver. James is saying that the whole divine Law has to be accepted as an expression of God's will for His people. The violation of even one commandment separates an individual from God and His purposes.
