Quoted or A Template

- An outline or template— Two Reasons:
- **Avoid Vain Repetition**
- *And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen do. For they think that they will be heard for their many words. 8 "Therefore do not be like them. For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him. 9 In this manner, therefore, pray: Mt. 6:7-9*
- **Has to be Modified Today**
- *Your kingdom come.* The kingdom is already here
- NKJV

Jesus Can't Be King without a Kingdom

- *John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, 2 and saying, "Repent, for **the kingdom of heaven is at hand!**"* Matt 3:1-3
- *Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, **preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God**, 15 and saying, "**The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand.** Repent, and believe in the gospel."* Mark 1:14-15
- *Jesus answered, "**My kingdom is not of this world.** If My kingdom were of this world, My servants would fight, so that I should not be delivered to the Jews; but now **My kingdom is not from here.**"* Jn 18:36

Jesus is King of Kings and Lord of Lords

- He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love,
- We are in the kingdom now as Jesus is our king now.
- How can he deliver the kingdom to God if it is not here yet? Col 1:13-14
- *Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power. 25 For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet. 26 The last enemy that will be destroyed is death. 1Cor. 15:24-26*
- If Jesus is not king now He will never be king.
- If He doesn't have a kingdom what will He deliver to God?

The Scripture Conclusion: A Template

- Each of these should be included in our prayers.
- Can't say they must be in every prayer. But **Can** say if we never do it, we are not praying properly.
- *In this manner, therefore, pray: Matt 6:9*
- This is in the imperative mode (a direct command)
- *houtho... in this manner, in the manner spoken of; in the way described; thus so... (Thayer, 3779)*
- If we are not obeying God will see it as sin.
- If we hear them and do them we build on rock.
- If we hear them and don't do we are build on sand:
