Bonus #5. Find the occurrences of "Adam" and "Eve" in the New Testament. What can we learn from them as well as from Gen. 2:18-24 & Matt. 19:3-9?

Bonus #6. Describe the "lie" of Gen. 3:4-5. Compare Gen. 3:6 and 1 John 2:16.

Bonus #7. Where did Cain's wife come from (Gen. 4)?

Bonus #8. How would you respond to someone who claimed the Great Flood occurred, but was local in nature, perhaps associated with a massive flooding of the Black Sea by the Mediterranean Sea?

Bonus #9. According to Gen. 12:1-3, what major promises did God give Abram? How and when were these promises fulfilled?
