True (Genuine) Worshippers

- But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. 24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth." <u>Jn. 4:23-24</u>
- New Covenant is the 'coming hour' that 'now is'
- God is <u>SEEKING</u> genuine worshippers.
- Because God is Spirit we must bow to His will
- True Worship <u>MUST</u> be in spirit and truth.

If We Truly Want to Worship

- We need to know what we are doing.
- We need to know why we are doing it.
- We need to have the verses in our heart.
- Create faith that comes by hearing the specific verses God has given for each act of worship.
- We must do exactly what God has asked.
- Anything more or less destroys reverence and nullifies to worship making it vain.
- How do we do this during the Lord's Supper?

An Unworthy Manner

Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks this cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. <u>1Cor 11:27-28</u>

This was the moment of transition. One moment He was with God and was God and the next moment He was flesh dwelling among us.

That was the moment when He spoke: body prepared

Another snapshot of the moment:

Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. <u>Phil 2:5-7</u> The body was prepared to become obedient to the point of death on the cross. This is the offering of body

God allowed Isaiah to foretell

For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, There is no beauty that we should desire Him. <u>Isa 53:1</u>

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. 6 All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all. Isa 53:5-6

For all these things to come to pass God prepared a body!

God allowed Isaiah to foretell Isa 52:13-14 Behold, My Servant shall deal prudently; He shall be exalted and extolled and be very high. 14 Just as many were astonished at you, So His visage was marred more than any man, And His form more than the sons of men;
