- 27 whoever eats this bread or drinks this cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.
- Worthy or unworthy based on what?
- If it is in spirit and truth it is worthy
- If either of these is lacking it is unworthy
- If it is unworthy to him comes the guilt of sin

An Unworthy Manner

Must worship in spirit and truth.

Truth = what God says we should do. Spirit = What God says we should feel

"anaxios"- Not "bringing up the other beam of the scales,"

"Not bringing into equilibrium"

- 28 so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup.
- The manner of *spirit* (feeling) and *truth* (thinking)
- 29 eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself
- A very serious examination Failure equals:
- 30 For this reason many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep
- Must activate our spirit based on truth.
- 31 if we judge ourselves, we would not be judged

THE BASIC PRINCIPLES OF BLOOD

- For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul Lev 17:11-12
- The life of the flesh is in the blood
- I have given blood to you upon the altar it is to make atonement for souls.
- For it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul

But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. 12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, 14 how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? Heb 9:11-15

- knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, 19 but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot. 1 Peter 1:18-21
- But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. 1 John 1:7

- To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, 6 and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. Rev 1:5-6
- Rev 5:9-10 "You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to God by Your blood For such a High Priest was fitting for us, ...

- The Symbolism of the blood and High Priest:
- But into the second part the high priest went alone once a year, not without blood, which he offered for himself and for the people's sins committed in ignorance; 8 the Holy Spirit indicating this, that the way into the Holiest of All was not yet made manifest while the first tabernacle was still standing. 9 It was symbolic for the present time in which both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make him who performed the service perfect in regard to the conscience Heb 9:7-9

- Rom 3:24-26 being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, 25 whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood,
- In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace 8
- Eph 2:13 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

- 18 Therefore not even the first covenant was dedicated without blood. 19 For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and goats,
- it was necessary that the copies of the things in the heavens should be purified with these, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these. 24 For Christ has not entered the holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us; 25 not that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood of another ... He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. Heb 9:23-26

- every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. 12 But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God, ... 14 For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified. Heb 10:11-18

Spirit & Truth = Thinking & Feeling

- What should we think about?
- The mocking, beatings, scourging, nails, spear
- The death, shedding of blood, pain, sorrow, suffering, anguish,
- Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken,
- Smitten by God, and afflicted. 5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. Isa 53:4-5
